

### Requesting Funding for TriBetaWest-1 District Convention

To Whom It May Concern,

We are requesting funding from the Student Government Association to assist in the costs of hosting the TriBeta District Convention at New Mexico Tech on April 29th and 30th. TriBeta Epsilon Chi Chapter is the only TriBeta organization in New Mexico. We have the honor of hosting this year's District Convention and we are looking forward to having schools from Colorado, Arizona, Utah, and Nevada. The Convention will include presentations, posters, and speakers from Biology departments from all participating schools.

In order to host this year's District Convention we need assistance in covering the costs for the Fidel Ballrooms. The cost of the ballrooms is \$1442. We are having three meals during the Convention including dinner Friday night at Chartwells, continental breakfast Saturday morning, and a fancy dinner Saturday evening. The total charge for all the food from Chartwells catering service is \$1954.50.

We are expecting around fifty people to attend the convention, including tech students and faculty from the biology department. The convention has a registration fee of \$60 that will help pay for food, goodies and t-shirts. Of the \$60 registration fee, \$40 dollars will go to covering the costs of each person's meal. The left over \$20 per person will go towards covering other costs such as the goodies and fees from renting the ballrooms. These numbers are based on if we have a total of 50 attendees who pay the \$60 registration fee since we do not yet have a final total number of people who are attending the convention. We are trying to waive the fee for Tech students that are presenting and any NMT staff from the Biology and Biomedical Sciences departments that are willing to help judge. Currently we have eleven people that are signed up to judge or present making a waived total of \$660.

With this being a large event full of undergraduates, admissions and graduate studies will use this event as recruiting to bring more students to tech. We have had lots of donations from these departments and have fundraised during Women's Fest to help cover any necessary costs. At Women's Fest we raised a total of \$265. The national TriBeta society also granted us a \$600 stipend to help host the convention. We will be using this money to order t-shirts that will cost \$575. We are asking for a total of \$3000 to cover the total cost of Fidel and other necessary expenses.
